# **SPLASH** Series

The most comfortable in-pool chair is here. Take a seat in the Woosah Chair and let your shoulders and arms relax. Now take a deep breath and say "Wooooo-saaaaah" while slowly exhaling. Repeat until you feel the tension wash away.

The ergonomic contouring of the seat makes for a very comfortable chair. The seat is made with soft contoured, rotationally molded polyethylene that can withstand sun, rain, snow, ice, and pool chemicals.

- Designed for in-pool use and has zero metal components.
- Great ergonomic seat profile and tall backrest.
- Supports up to 350 lbs
- Easy to add to the pool and easy to remove from the pool. No screw plugs to deal with.
- Leg bases are rounded for use in all types of pools, including vinyl liner.











Woosah gives the user the feel of a comfort enhanced Adirondack chair. Perfect for use in your pool sun shelf or on the patio. If you have a sun shelf this chair works in up to 13" of water without added weights. Drop in two 4lb coated diving weights into the base during assembly and this chair will work in up to 16" water depth (weights are sold by others). Drain holes are designed into the bottom of each leg and pool water is allowed to freely recirculate through the core of the chair to reduce internal algae growth. Place Woosah in your pool and it rests on the bottom. Simply lift the chair from the pool and the water releases from the core and it's ready to use immediately on the patio – no drain plugs to remove, and no heavy water locked into the core.



### STANDARD COLORS

### INCLUDED PARTS



Easy assembly. No tools required.

## Step 1

Spread out a towel or moving blanket. You can also cut the sides of the box so the box spreads out flat on the ground. This is to protect the seat and the base from scratching during assembly.

### Step 2

Place the plastic seat upside down on the towel or blanket so the bottom of the chair is facing towards you.



# Step 3

Turn the connector screw knob counter clockwise to expand each connector. Align the raised ridges on the base with the channels on the bottom of the seat. Hold the pieces together while inserting all 4 connectors through base and into the bottom of the seat. You'll see the "key holes" aligned that accept the head of the connector.



### Step 4

Turn the outer ring of each connector to the right (clockwise) 90 degrees. Hold this outer ring at the 90 degree position while twisting the head of the center plastic screw until it is securely tightened by hand. Do not use a pliers or tools to turn the connectors. Hand tightening is enough and assembly is complete.
